### Code of Conduct

The objectives of Mission World Aid are established on the principle of “I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you invited me in, I needed clothes and you clothed me, I was sick and you looked after me, I was in prison and you came to visit me” Matthew25:35-36 (NIV).

The core objective is to assist, promote and work in co-operation with other organisations for the relief of poverty, starvation and disease amongst peoples of the world.

Jesus Christ is our example as we reach out to help others. The people associated with Mission World Aid rely on and refer to the Holy Bible to inform, establish and maintain ways of operating and behaving when working towards meeting the objects of the association which are clearly identified in the Constitution. We believe that all those in the association should heed the scripture – “the fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom and the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding” [Proverbs 9:10].

Accordingly, Mission World Aid holds the following values close to heart

1. To **Love** the Lord our God and to love one another as He has loved us.
2. To **Give** cheerfully and generously of ourselves and our possessions.
3. To **Seek Justice** for, empower and protect the lives of people in need.
4. To develop and carefully **Steward** the human, financial and other resources of the Association.
